

PROTECT YOUR SSD AGAINST DATA LOSS



ENABLED SSD WRITE CACHING IS DANGEROUS WITH OUT ANY [UPS-BACKUP-SYSTEM](#).

DURING SHUT DOWN A POWER FAULT CAN DESTROY THE MBR OF THE SSD, BECAUSE THE DATA ARE MAY STILL IN THE CACHE OF THE SSD INSTEAD IN THE STORAGE AREA.

TO WRITE STRAIT TO THE STORAGE AREA FROM THE SSD, FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTION BELOW.

- OPEN "DEVICE MANAGER" AND SELECT "DRIVES"
- SELECT YOUR SSD-DRIVE AND DOUBLECLICK ON IT
- ENTER TO "POLICIES"
- **UN-CHECK** "ENABLE WRITE CACHING ON THE DEVICE"
